

Endo Public Policy Committee (“EPPC”) Charter

I. Purpose

The purpose of the Endo Public Policy Committee, (“EPPC”), is to provide an executive level forum to engage in public policy discussions to help shape and direct the Company’s efforts with respect to public policies that support medical innovation, appropriate patient care and access to medicines.

II. Membership

Membership on this committee is composed of Endo’s Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Chief Financial Officer (CFO), Chief Legal Officer (CLO), Chief Operating Officer (COO), Chief Compliance Officer, Senior Vice President of Corporate Affairs, and Senior Vice President of Government Affairs who also chairs this committee.

III. Objectives

The objectives and responsibilities of the EPPC include:

- To increase members’ awareness and understanding of public policy issues and initiatives affecting medical innovation and appropriate patient care and access to medicines as well as Endo’s business and product portfolio;
- To assist members in identifying, evaluating, and monitoring social, political, and environmental trends, issues and concerns;
- To assist members in analyzing how public policy trends could impact Endo’s business activities and performance;
- To assist members in determining how Endo can anticipate and adjust to public policy trends and serve as an important contributor to the public dialogue, in each case in order to more effectively achieve Endo’s business goals;
- To assist members in analyzing Endo’s global reputation and developing recommendations to strategically position Endo to support its business objectives;
- To formulate and adopt policies, programs, and practices concerning priority public policy issues; and,
- To focus on the development of Endo specific public policy positions, and support the Endo business strategy.
